From the desk of Pastor Mark Hollinger

I have a smart phone, a really smart phone. It's a *OnePlus 6* and it has a lot of memory and a great camera and does everything that my first tower office computer did and more. It's amazing that our everyday cell phones has more computing power than the computers that were used for the Apollo missions that took us to the moon and back. The modern cell phone is like having a supercomputer in your pocket or purse. I, and I would venture many of you, have become fairly dependent on the utility and effectiveness of your cell phone.

What makes our cell phones ever more powerful and utilitarian are all the apps that we can download and use. So I have a weather app, the accuweather app, that gives me weather radar, hourly and daily forecasts. It's absolutely fantastic when there's a weather advisory for your area and you have a Doppler weather radar at your fingertips. I also have our recent church directory on my cell phone which allows me to access emails and phone numbers of everyone registered and the ability to email and call with the ease of accessing a family profile.

Of course none of these modern miracles and conveniences are any good unless you download them to your phone and then use them—apply them—thus the appropriate term—a phone app. This is also true of God's word. The Bible is a wonderful tool and has all things necessary for our proper living and purpose, indeed all things necessary for salvation, but is of no use unless we open it up, read it and then apply what we read into our lives.

Some years ago I came across a wonderful tool for reading and applying scripture into our lives. Like many useful tools it's an acronym: SOAPY. S=scripture that is read, O=observation of what the scripture directs, A=applying the scripture in your life, Y=discovering what we may need to yield in order to apply the scripture lesson into our lives and then P=prayer for guidance and strength through the process of getting that scripture into a life application. It's not enough to read the Bible but to do what it instructs.

In the month of September we will have a life app sermon series. We will see how we are to apply the lessons of the Bible into our lives. One sermon will be the life app for forgiveness, another on the life app of trust and another on the life app of kindness. We will also have the added blessing of the youth having our worship celebration and message on September 22.

I hope that you will join us for these important life app messages. Jesus at the end of His Sermon on the Mount in the gospel of Matthew says this at the end of those dramatic teachings.

“Whoever hears these words of Mine and does them, will be like a wise man who built his house on rock. The rain came down. The water came up. The wind blew and hit the house. The house did not fall because it was built on rock.” Matthew 7:24-25

Pastor Mark and the lay and staff leadership of Cridersville UMC ask that you be in prayer as we start the process of preparing our 2020 church budget. Please pray for God's guidance in this process of preparation and our disciple call to support the church with our financial commitments.

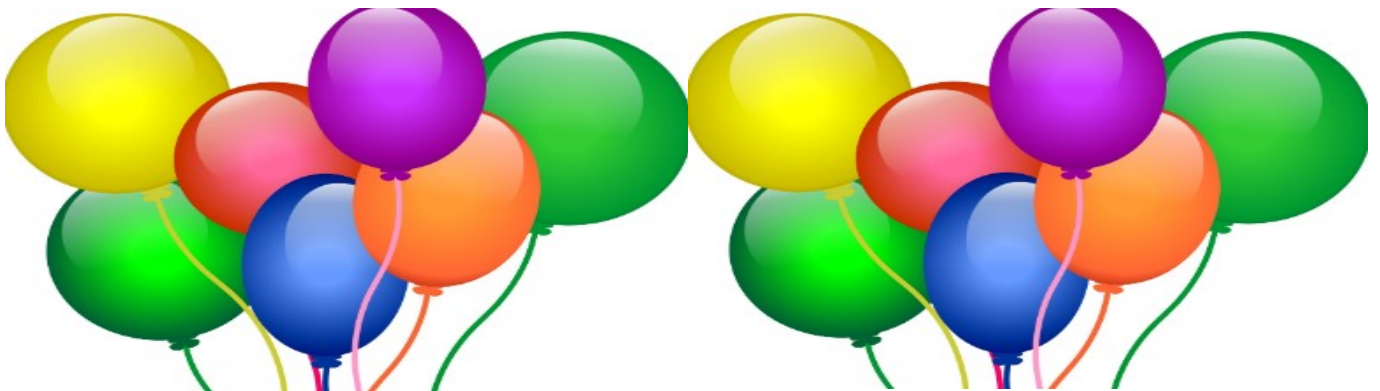

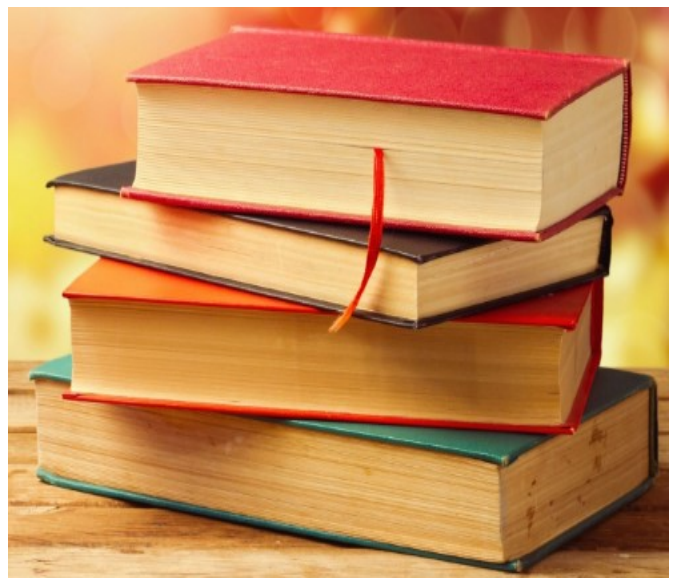


GOD'S PROMISES & ANSWERS, For Your Life”.
